Every week there will be a different theme from Meadow Madness, Life Underground to Wild Water and the beloved Peter Pan.

Sadler's Wells, Breakin' Convention presents, on Sunday 8 August, The King and Queen of the Cobblestones, featuring the best breakers in the UK battling it out Bonnie and Clyde style in the Covent Garden piazza. Also, live graffiti art featuring the NEWNION JACK on Carnaby Street, and a variety of immersive performances to entertain and energise

South Kensington Green Trail

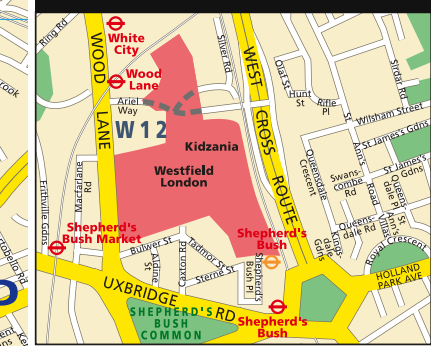
